New members receive a copy of the current Newsletter and Opusculum, information about the annual Symposium, and about the Society's activities. Any other Society publication will normally be paid for separately. Any back publications will be charged for separately (if still in print).

Members are reminded that prompt payment of subscriptions enables the Society to continue to publish its Newsletters and Opuscula.
